

He, the Undersigned, James A. Hamilton, Acting Secretary of State of the United States; and Sr. Silvestro Rebello, Officer of the Imperial Order of the Crossier, and Chargé d'Affaires of His Majesty the Emperor of Brazil, near the said United States; do hereby certify that the Ratifications of the Treaty, or General Convention of Peace, Friendship, Commerce and Navigation, signed at Rio de Janeiro, on the 12th of December 1828, between the United States of America, and His Majesty the Emperor of Brazil, have, this day, with all suitable solemnities and after due comparison with the original

by us.

In witness whereof, we have signed
this Act, executed in both languages, and
have sealed the same with our respective
seals, at the City of Washington, this
eighteenth day of March, one thousand
eight hundred and twenty nine.
